Victory for PSA members in Mpumalanga

Department of Higher Education and Training

An Educator member who was contract based, with the employer also contributing to his benefits towards the GEPF, was prejudiced from receiving the same after he was permanently appointed. The member approached the central office and was taken from pillar and decided to approach the PSA. A dispute was lodged through the PSCBC wherein the employer was compelled to submit the official's exit documents through the GEPF. In December, the member was delighted to announce he had received a sum of R55 000.

Department of Basic Education

Charges of misconduct were proffered against a member who had participated in an unprotected strike for four days. The member was represented in the disciplinary hearing and a guilty ruling was issued by the Chairperson. The PSA mitigated for the member, and he received a sanction of a final written warning. This is a victory to the member as the sanction could have been harsh with financial implications.

Department of Home Affairs

A member was charged in a disciplinary hearing with four charges related to the acceptance of bribery money for foreign immigrants. He was represented by the PSA and found not guilty on all charges proffered against him. The member is very satisfied with the service received from the PSA.
