When leading with respect, the PSA contributes to building workplaces that are safer, more innovative, and more resilient.

Trust is earned through respect. For PSA shop stewards, every interaction is an opportunity to earn trust by being present, fair, and professional. It is about listening with empathy, responding with courtesy, and valuing every member's voice.

When members feel heard and respected, they are more likely to engage, contribute, and trust the Union to represent their interests. Being honest, even when the truth is uncomfortable, shows real respect. Shop stewards must be transparent, not just about successes, but also about challenges. By openly sharing information, including success and challenges, the Union demonstrates respect and integrity. Transparency and honesty cultivate a culture of mutual trust. Respect is also about reliability. Keeping your word shows that members can count on the PSA and builds lasting credibility.

At the heart of the PSA's work is the protection and advocacy of members' rights. This includes creating safe and respectful workplaces, challenging unfair practices and inequality, and valuing member input in every decision. When shop stewards truly respect members, they become champions of dignity and fairness. They lead with heart and never forget why they do this work.
