## **State Attorney's Office**

As it was previously reported that the PSA invoked *clause 17* for the matter to be facilitated by the General Secretary of Council. The employer was aware of the challenges in the Office but was not serious in addressing these, hence *clause 17* was invoked. It was reported in the meeting that the task team did not sit as a result of the report that was not circulated by the employer prior to the meeting. The task meeting was therefore rescheduled for 20 November 2019. Members will be updated on the outcome of the meeting.

## **PMDS at NPA**

The PSA previously tabled this matter, demanding that the employer must implement PMDS payments. The employer reported in the previous meeting that all employees were paid, except the Legal Advisory Division. The PSA has received complaints from members, alleging non-payment of bonuses. The names were forwarded to employer to make payments to these members. The employer will, upon verification of payment, respond to the PSA's demand.

## **Metro File**

The PSA previously demanded that the contract for filing, which was concluded between the employer and Metro File, be cancelled owing to delays members are experiencing in retrieving files Metro File. The employer has since reported that a Committee was established to monitor the efficiency of the system on a monthly basis and some improvements were made. The PSA will verify the information for further engagement in the meeting. Members are requested to inform the PSA if the problems still persist.
