Merger

The President pronounced in his State of Nation Address on 16 February 2018 that growth, development and transformation depend on a strong and capable state. It was critical that the structure and the size of the state must be optimally suited to meet the needs of people and ensure the most efficient allocation of public resources. The state initiated a process to review the configuration, the number and size of national government departments. The new Cabinet was announced on 29 May 2019. The configuration was announced on 14 June 2019. The configuration of the new Cabinet introduced numerous changes.

Subsequently, parties in the Public Service Coordinating Bargaining Council (PSCBC) entered into a framework agreement to regulate the process. The most important objective of the framework agreement is to regulate the process by providing guidelines on the identification, transfer and placement of staff in a transparent, fair and inclusive process that allows meaningful participation and consultation with all stakeholders.

Start-up structure
