PSA ATTENDS PARLIAMENTARY INQUIRY INTO STEINHOFF

The Public Servants Association (PSA), representing some 240 000 Public Service employees, will on **Wednesday, 5 September 2018** attend a Parliamentary inquiry into the collapse of shares by Steinhoff International.

PSA acting General Manager, Tahir Maepa, and Assistant General Manager, Leon Gilbert, will attend the inquiry session where former Steinhoff CEO, Markus Jooste, will be questioned about his role in the loss of billions of public servants' pensions invested in Steinhoff by the Public Investment Corporation on behalf of the Government Employees Pension Fund
