

**MEDIA RELEASE** Progressive engagement between Registrar of Labour Relations and the PSA on Unions status

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The Public Servants Association (PSA) wishes to update members and supporters on the ongoing and constructive engagement between the Registrar of Labour Relations and the Union regarding the Registrar's intention to cancel the registration of the PSA as a trade union in terms of the *Labour Relations Act, 1995 (LRA)*.

The PSA and the Registrar met today and engaged in discussions aimed at resolving the matters raised by the Registrar. The Union remains committed to addressing these matters constructively and in full accordance with the provisions of the *LRA*. The Registrar has confirmed that the PSA remains a genuine and fully registered trade union, retaining all rights and obligations to represent its members, engage in collective bargaining, and exercise all rights conferred upon it in terms of the *LRA*.

Both the Registrar and the PSA have expressed their commitment to resolving this matter in the best interests of members, recognising the important role and significance of the Union within the public service. Members and the supporters will continue to be updated on any further developments. The PSA appreciates the ongoing trust, support, and commitment of its members.

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
