

MEDIA RELEASE PSA calls for improved security controls at Jade Square Building in North

West

The Public Servants Association (PSA) is concerned about the safety of workers following an armed robbery at Jade Square Building in Klerksdorp in North West, which accommodates three government departments.

The building, which accommodates the Departments of Sports, Arts and Culture, Economic Development and Tourism, and Social Development, was entered by criminals earlier this week. Employees were robbed at gunpoint of their belongings, including cell phones and laptops.

This alarming incident is a clear indication that security measures at Jade Square Building are not sufficient. The PSA urges the Departments to immediately engage with the landlord to implement tighter security measures that will prevent similar incidents in future. The PSA has forwarded letters to the heads of departments to consider this request and reminding employers of their responsibilities to provide a safe working environment for employees. The safety of employees is priority, and the PSA is committed to ensuring a safe work environment for its members.
