The Public Servants Association (PSA) is concerned about the inadequate number of Security Officers deployed at various offices of the Department of Home Affairs in KwaZulu-Natal.

The situation is as a result of Treasury reducing the budget allocated for security services for the Department. Some offices have experienced security breaches at entrances. In offices where two security officers are required, such entrances are now being controlled by only one Security Officer. This has also resulted in certain instances of members of the public displaying unruly and unacceptable behaviour.

This situation has significantly impacted on employees, affecting their health, safety, and the provision of services. The PSA urges the Department of Home Affairs to prioritise the safety of offices in the interest of employees and members of the public.
