The Public Servants Association (PSA), in the Free State in collaboration with Tswellang Special School have launched a special project aimed at assisting the School, located in Bloemfontein, in acquiring much-needed wheelchairs for their students. The project is centred around collecting bread clips and bottle caps, with the aim of raising funds to purchase 10 wheelchairs for the school.

To procure a single wheelchair requires volunteers to collect either 450 Kilograms of bottle tops or 50 Kilograms of bread tags. Therefore, a total of 4500 Kilograms of bottle tops or 500 Kilograms of bread tags is needed to achieve this goal. The PSA in Bloemfontein is calling on the Unions members and the public at large to support us in this endeavour.

The project will commence on July 27, 2023, and will run until November 30, 2023. During this period, individuals can contribute their bread clips and bottle tops by delivering them to either Tswellang Special School or the PSA Provincial Office, situated at 34 First Avenue, Westdene, Bloemfontein.

The PSA recognises the importance of empowering individuals with disabilities and providing them with the necessary tools for a fulfilling life. The Union of Choice believes that by joining hands and working together, we can make a significant impact on the lives of these students.
