The Public Servants Association (PSA) demonstrated the Union's continued commitment to support of South African communities in need when on 13 March 2026, the PSA's Provincial Office in Limpopo delivered food parcels to families severely affected by recent floods in the Vhembe and Mopani Districts.

This initiative formed part of the PSA's ongoing corporate social investment programme. Delegates included the PSA President, Mr Justice Shiburi, PSA staff, shop stewards, full-time shop stewards, who joined hands to bring much-needed relief to distressed families following recent devastating floods that left many vulnerable households without basic necessities, exposing them to severe food insecurity and shelter challenges.

Community leaders and beneficiaries expressed heartfelt gratitude to the PSA, acknowledging the Union's compassion and commitment to the well-being of communities. The PSA recognises that its responsibility extends beyond the workplace, standing firmly with public servants and ordinary citizens during times of crisis. The PSA believes that a union must not only defend workers' rights but is also responsive to broader social challenges faced by society. Through this humanitarian initiative, the PSA reaffirms the Union's position as a caring, people-centred organisation that stands with communities in their hour of need.

The PSA calls upon the Premier of Limpopo, relevant government stakeholders, civil-society organisations, and the business cluster to urgently prioritise the provision of decent housing and comprehensive social relief to affected families. The floods, which are still occurring in Limpopo, highlighted the dire need for sustainable interventions that protect vulnerable communities from recurring disasters and ensure their dignity and safety.
