# **PSA TO OPPOSE DEPARTMENT OF NATIONAL HEALTH'S INTERDICT TO FORCE EMPLOYEES TO WORK IN CIVITAS BUILDING**

**6 September 2018**

The Public Servants Association (PSA) will oppose the National Department of National Health's urgent interdict to force its employees to render services from Civitas Building in the Pretoria CBD. The building has declared uninhabitable by the Department of Labour.

The Department's application comes after its employees indicated that they no longer feel safe to enter the building. The PSA represent thousands of employees of the Department and is also busy with a urgent court application to shut down the building, which according to reports by the Department of Labour and the National Health Laboratory Services, is not fit for occupation.

The matter will be hear in the Pretoria High Court today, 6 September 2018.
