The Public Servants Association (PSA) is saddened by the tragic loss of lives and destruction of property experienced by communities in the Vhembe and Mopani Districts of Limpopo as a result of major floods.

Heavy rains and subsequent floods swept away more than 26 houses and claimed the lives of more than 30 people, including children. The PSA commends the swift response of municipalities in the affected districts, which immediately sought assistance from the business community and the public to provide devastated families with shelter and other necessities.

The PSA is, however, gravely concerned about the silence of the Limpopo Provincial Government regarding employees residing in the affected areas. Clear guidance and support are urgently needed to ensure that these employees are assisted appropriately and are not further burdened during this time of crisis.

The PSA calls on the Provincial Government to urgently address this matter and provide direction on how affected employees should be supported in terms of workplace arrangements and humanitarian relief.

The PSA stands in solidarity with all affected families and communities and reaffirms the Union's commitment to advocating for the well-being of employees and citizens during this difficult time.
