

MEDIA RELEASE PSA mourns the tragic death of Prosecutor Elona Sombulula, demands swift

The Public Servants Association (PSA) is deeply shocked and saddened by the senseless killing of Mr Elona Sombulula, a dedicated 30-year-old prosecutor who was tragically gunned down in Ngcobo, Eastern Cape, earlier this week.

Mr Sombulula, a capable legal professional who joined the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) through its aspirant prosecutor programme in 2022, had already made a significant impact as a Regional Court Prosecutor. His death is not only a profound loss to the legal community but also a serious blow to the country's justice system. The PSA extends its heartfelt condolences to Mr Sombulula's family, colleagues, and the entire NPA, particularly in the Eastern Cape region. As one of the "rising stars" of the Prosecuting Authority, his commitment to upholding the rule of law and serving the public with integrity must be honoured through swift and decisive action.

The PSA calls on law enforcement authorities to prioritise the investigation into this brutal act and ensure that those responsible are swiftly brought to justice. The safety of prosecutors and all public servants is non-negotiable, and this incident underscores the urgent need for enhanced security measures to protect officials who carry out critical functions in our justice system. The PSA also offers support to its members within the NPA who are affected by this tragedy and urges the employer to provide psychological support to all staff impacted by this loss.

Mr Sombulula's life and service must not be forgotten. The PSA stands in solidarity with the NPA and all those who strive to uphold justice under increasingly dangerous conditions.
