In the spirit of active citizenship and community upliftment, the Public Servants Association (PSA) will once again honour Mandela Day by participating in clean-up initiatives across several provinces on 18 July 2025. Staff, Full-Time Shop Stewards (FTSS), PSA structure members and members will roll up their sleeves and take tangible action to improve public spaces in line with the call to dedicate 67 minutes for positive change.

The PSA is proud to confirm participation in the following areas:

KwaZulu-Natal (Pietermaritzburg)

Clean-up of Jabu Ndlovu Street, focusing on litter collection and water drain clearing. All staff, FTSS, and structure members will commence activities at 12h00.

• KwaZulu-Natal (Durban)

Litter removal and grounds maintenance (including grass cutting) will take place at Gobhogobho Primary School. All staff, FTSS, and structure members will begin work at 12:00.

• Limpopo (Polokwane)

Staff and members will clean sidewalks and public spaces on Excelsior Street. Activities start at 12:00.

• Gauteng (Pretoria)

The Pretoria office will lead a clean-up operation on an identified stretch of road next to Stanza Bopape Clinic and Mams Square Shopping Centre in Mamelodi, targeting litter hotspots from 12:00.

• Gauteng (Johannesburg)

The Johannesburg team will clean public areas in the Braamfontein area. Activities commence at 12:00.

• Eastern Cape (Mthatha)

Staff and members will clean up the Northcrest Taxi Rank. Activities start at 12:00.

• Eastern Cape (Gqeberha)

The Ggeberha team will clean the Cape Recife beach. Activities commence at 12:00.

• Free State (Bloemfontein)

PSA staff will clean the open space adjacent to the Provincial Office and the pavement, which have been left unclean by the Mangaung Metro. Activities commence at 12:00.

Mpumalanga (Nelspruit)

Staff and members will clean up the Msogwaba Clinic. Activities start at 12:00.

• Northern Cape (Kimberley)

PSA staff and members will embark on a clean-up at Resthaven Welfare Society. Activities start at 09:00.

North West (Mahikeng)

PSA staff and members will embark on a clean-up at Mahikeng Provincial Hospital. Activities start at 10:00.

• Western Cape (Cape Town)

Staff and members will clean District 6 CDC, cnr Caledon and Mount Street, Zonnebloem, CBD. Activities start at 10:00.
