National Macro Organisation of Government (NMOG): Configuration

Merger

During the State of Nation Address, the President emphasized the importance of growth, development and transformation, in order to render the state strong and capable. By inference, the structure and the size of the Government must be optimally suited to address what is needed by people, ensuring that the available public resources be efficiently allocated. To achieve these virtues, it was incumbent that the number and sizes of the national government be reconfigured. After the announcement of the new Cabinet in June 2019, the latter introduced several changes. Parties in the Public Service Coordinating Bargaining Council (PSCBC) concluded a collective agreement to ensure that the rights of members are protected and to give effect to the re-configuration process. In line with the agreement, the GPSSBC established Task Teams to ensure that proper consultation on the process takes place.

Start-up structure

The GPSSBC chairs the Task Teams. The employer presented the overhead Macro start-up structure of the new **Department of Environment, Forestry and Fisheries (DEFF)**. It will present the Micro and the Matching and Placing template at the next meeting. The next meeting will be convened on or before 31 January 2020.
