Seminar: Labour Law Updates and Workshop Fourth Industrial Revolution and its impact on labour rights and collective bargaining: Gauteng Johannesburg Area 30 September to 1 October 2019

The PSA will be rolling out a seminar and workshop on Labour Law updates and the Fourth Industrial Revolution, in order to develop Shop Stewards and members, and empower them with the knowledge to represent themselves and others and be aware of their employment rights. This seminar is open to all PSA members, shop stewards, Liaison Officers and Labour Relations Officers who register for the seminar.

The Labour Law updates seminar will focus on current changes and developments in South African labour legislation and the application of labour laws. It will focus on recent cases and judgements relevant to the public sector and the effects and implications of such legislation.

The workshop on the Fourth Industrial Revolution and its impact on collective bargaining, will provide a brief description of the first three waves of the Industrial Revolution and responses to these and a description of the Fourth Industrial Revolution and its impact on labour rights and collective bargaining, with a focus on the Impact in the Public Service. It will also explore the labour responses and what the best practice model is available for the PSA to use for the benefits of members and the public.
