Seminar on labour law updates and workshop on Fourth Industrial Revolution and its impact on labour rights and collective bargaining: Polokwane - 4 – 5 November 2019

Lailah Gifty Akita said that “All the training was necessary for my personal development”, a view shared by the PSA that training of members leads to holistic personal development and growth. As part of continuous learning, the PSA will be rolling out a seminar and workshop on labour law updates and the Fourth Industrial Revolution, which is open to **all PSA members, shop stewards, Liaison Officers and Labour Relations Officers.**

The labour law updates seminar will focus on current changes and developments in South African labour legislation and the application of labour laws, with specific reference to recent cases and judgements relevant to the public sector and the effects and implications of such legislation.

The workshop on the Fourth Industrial Revolution and its impact on collective bargaining will provide a brief description of the first three waves of the Industrial Revolution and responses to these and a description of the Fourth Industrial Revolution and its impact on labour rights and collective bargaining, with a focus on the Impact in the Public Service. It will also explore labour responses and how best the PSA can respond for the benefits of members and the public.

Registration of delegates will be closed at the end of July 2019. Interested members are advised to act swiftly as space is limited. Unregistered delegates will not be allowed access to the seminar and workshop.
