- · Public Service wage cuts
- · Reduction in performance bonuses
- Re-configuration of the Public Service resulting in the loss of jobs
- Unilateral change in calculations of pension benefits as well as mismanagement of the Government Employees Pension Fund, resulting in the weakening of pension benefits of public servants
- Reduction of 30 000 posts by luring employees between 55 and 60 years of age into early retirement
