## **Update: Northern Cape PHSDSBC**

Members have been kept informed of developments through previous editions of the *Informus* (copies can be obtained from the PSA's website (<a href="www.psa.co.za">www.psa.co.za</a>) or from the PSA Provincial Office). Only one agenda point was discussed on PHSDSBC Chamber meeting on 24 January 2019, namely "the Court Interdict".

The employer (Northern Cape: Health) applied to interdict shop stewards from entering the Department's premises, harassing and intimidating officials of the Department. The Court hearing for the Interim Interdict was heard on 1 February 2019. It was withdrawn by the applicants at the Court. Labour committed to be fully represented at the next Council meeting scheduled for **23 May 2019**. Members will be informed of developments.
