Positive COVID-19 case: Hallmark building

It has come to the attention of the PSA that a positive case of COVID-19 was confirmed on 17 June 2020, at the National Office, Hallmark building. The PSA has written to the Compliance Officer and the Director-General to release the employees in that building as a matter of urgency. The PSA requested that the building be decontaminated, and that the affected employees be screened accordingly before the office is re-opened. The employer must implement appropriate health and safety measures according to the COVID-19 regulations and OHS protocols to protect the employees from further infections. The employer was further requested to issue a *communique* to employees to give clear directive in this regard.

The members are advised to report any dissatisfaction in this regard to the PSA through the shop stewards. The PSA will continue to engage the management and provide updates in this regard.
