Update: Containment of COVID-19 measures

Members are aware that Friday, 27 March 2020 was the first day of lockdown after announced by the President of the country. The Limpopo Provincial Management of the Department of Home Affairs made the following measures during the lock own of 21 days:

- Members will only perform three functions during the lock down period, i.e. issuing of death and birth certificates as well as reissuing of ID documents.
- All big offices, namely, Polokwane, Tzaneen, Jane Furse, Phalaborwa, Mokopane, Giyani and Thohoyandou will not exceed five employees whereas medium and small offices are restricted to a maximum of five employees.
- Members identified to work during the lockdown are issued with permits to work on a rotational basis. All other members not identified to work during the period of lockdown should stay home and be safe unless called to assist as and when necessary.

The PSA is advising members to make sure that the offices where members will be working during the lockdown period comply with the minimum safety standards.

Members are further advised to make sure they follow the safety standards to ensure that the they are safe during this crisis.
