Annual General Meeting (AGM)

The determination of Vote Weights was held in respect of this Departmental Chamber. The Council's Chairperson outlined Clause 16.1 of the Resolution 1/2012, implemented in conjunction with the Governance Rules of the Chambers as of 31 December 2019 on how the votes are determined.

The confirmation of vote weights by all parties were as follows:

- PSA with 90% of the vote weights representing a membership of 137**
- NEHAWU with 7.28% is having 11 members and**
- POPCRU with 3 with members, which converts to 1.97%**

Parties subsequently had a caucus on the Election of Office Bearers of the Chamber. The PSA proposed the existing Chairperson for re-election, which the employer rejected, without any reason. The employer then proposes a nominee, of which the PSA is having serious reservations due to his involvement within the department. There was a proposal that the employer must add two nominees for consideration, in finalising the filling of this key position. The employer requested that this item, as well as the Deputy Chairperson: Employer be deferred to the next Chamber meeting.

The PSA Branch mandated the nomination of Ms. Noxolo Ntsiko as the Deputy Chairperson: Labour. Her performance was outstanding as a Deputy Chairperson of the Chamber. The PSA would like to express its gratitude in having such valuable members within the organisation.

The employer requested that the Chamber meeting be postponed to 7 October 2020.
