Feedback: Annual General Meeting (AGM)

The determination of vote weights was presented in terms of the provisions of clause 16.1 of Resolution 1/2012, and the Governance Rules for the Chambers, as of 31 December 2019. The following was the determination for noting by the parties:

- The PSA has a commanding majority with 5 255 members (61,05%)
- Nehawu has a membership of 2 922 (33,95%)
- Popcur has a membership of 430 (5%)

Parties reached consensus on re-electing the previous Chairperson: Ms Linda Nthulane. The PSA National Chairperson: Ms Anadele Coetzee has been democratically elected as the Deputy Chairperson: Labour. The employer reported that it will provide a nominee for its Deputy Chairperson in the next meeting.

The PSA would like to applaud members and all DOD structures for the retention of the majority members. Structures and members are encouraged to intensify recruitment of new members in the Department to ensure that the PSA retains the majority membership in the Department. Members will be informed of developments.
