Update: NMOG process

A follow up Departmental Task Team (DTT) meeting was convened on 12 June 2020. The employer reported that they have resolved to complete the transfer of assets and the office accommodation of the transferred employees on 1 July 2020. The employer further reported that amongst the transferred employees, Chief Directors will each be allocated an office and the Directors will share office with their support staff as a temporary arrangement. The employer reported that they are in a process of securing new office accommodation and they are waiting for the Department of Public Works to complete its processes.

The PSA noted the report, but was concerned regarding employees who would share offices space amid the COVID-19 pandemic. The PSA requested the employer to observe social distancing to avoid any infections. The PSA proposed that the employer should apply a rotational system so that the employees could report for duty on different times. The employer acknowledged the suggestion by the PSA and would advise their principals accordingly.

The PSA will keep the members updated about the developments in this regard.
