Eastern Cape clinics temporary close to allow COVID-19 positive employees to self isolate and quarantine

The PSA was alerted of 10 staff members who tested positive for COVID-19 at the Port St Johns Health Centre. The centre is temporarily closed, and infected employees are being quarantined at the recovery centre.

Uguie Clinic temporarily closed on 16 July 2020, after two of its employees tested COVID-19 positive. Considering this, the PSA demanded mass testing for employees. Employees are reminded that they should put pressure on the employers to disinfect and thoroughly clean all areas where the COVID-19 positive employee worked or visited. All surfaces and objects that the infected person/s came into contact with must be cleaned.
