## PSA supports stance by DOH to support health frontline workers

The PSA is relieved by the decision taken by health management, to intensify efforts to increase the number of professional nurses and doctors within the province to prevent unnecessary loss of life, as a result of the lack of access to critical care services.

To this end the department has embarked on a recruitment drive to head hunt professional nurses and doctors (both specialist and general). Management confirmed that the department is preparing for a surge in numbers, as the projected peak of the pandemic is approaching, with an anticipated pressure on critical care services. The PSA is following and participating in the recruitment processes in making sure that the process of recruitment and appointments are done in a fair and transparent process.
