PSA urges members to be more vigilant during level-2 of lock down

The PSA hereby calls on members and Shop Stewards to be vigilant in complying and monitoring compliance with COVID-19 protocols in departments. The rapid rise in the number of COVID-19 cases in public institutions is a serious concern.

The PSA has been steadfast in its quest to ensure that all government departments, observe the prescribed protocols in combating and managing the spread of COVID-19, since the outbreak in March 2020. The PSA further applauds shop stewards who have been fighting for the health and safety of our members. As we are now on level-2, the PSA would like to encourage both members and shop stewards to remain vigilant in the fight against COVID-19 in the workplace. The PSA will continue monitoring employers to ensure sufficient Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is provided and that there is regular deep-cleaning of workplaces. Members must make sure employers conduct regular screening and sanitising of officials and visitors at all departmental entrances.
