Provincial PMDS

According to the Provincial PMDS policy all departments were expected to complete moderation and pay all PMDS incentives by 31 December 2019. Most departments paid on time except for Community Safety & Transport Management, Public Works and Roads and Agriculture and Rural Development who paid by the 21 March 2020. However, the Department of Health did not complete the 2018/2019 moderations due to various internal challenges and this issue ventilated further on a scheduled sectoral meeting of 24 July 2020.

Performance agreements for 2019/2020, of the employees on salary levels 1 to 12 and SMS members, were due on the 31 May 2020 and not yet submitted due to COVID-19 and lockdown.

Resolution 1/2007

The overall vacancy rate of the province is 15.6%, which is higher that the norm as outlined by DPSA. The Department with the highest vacancy rate is Agriculture and Rural Development at 35.9%, Cooperate Governance and Traditional Affairs at 28%, Arts, Culture, and Sports and Recreation 20.8% and Provincial Treasury at 19.7%. The high rate is as the result of the ongoing merging the departments in line with the president's proclamation.

Provincial Work from Home Policy

The employer in line with DPSA Circular 18 of 2020 regarding Occupational Health and Safety and implementation of COVID-19 Regulation no. 11098, drafted a Provincial Work from Home Policy to be consulted on.

The draft policy was distributed, and an agreement captured as follows:
