## Update: Meeting 19 March 2020

The PSA had a meeting with the employer on 19 March 2020 where the current situation with regard to COVID-19 was discussed. The employer indicated its willingness to comply with the Ministerial Directive issued on 18 March 2020 and has put in place various measures to ensure compliance.

Hand sanitisation is taking place and to ensure this being more effective, the employer has undertaken to disconnect the fingerprint access control on the various floors. The employer is also in the process of issuing a directive to allow a certain percentage of the staff to from work remotely. The directive will include various other measures in line with the Ministerial Directive to ensure the containment of the virus. The PSA, however, noted the absence of face masks and temperature screening devices.
