Update: Members in the Eastern Cape regarding COVID-19 (Corona Virus)

With the confirmation of the first case of the COVID-19 virus in the Eastern Cape, the PSA in the Port Elizabeth office has written to all departments and implored them to strengthen their efforts in combating the spread of the virus. In the communication PSA sensitizes all the departments to put stringent measures to make sure that all the guidelines and action plans that were adopted are adhered to by all departments in trying to contain the spread of the virus.

The PSA further urged those departments that deal with the public to safeguard their employees in-line with the DPSA circular and to have necessities like sanitizers and screenings, in the points of entry, to be installed immediately.

We are also encouraging all our members including shop stewards to be vigilant, in their relevant departments, to avoid mass gatherings and report any deviation in their institution from the Presidents pronouncement to the PSA and further, for all public servants to observe hygiene to lessen the risk of infection and spread of the virus.
