## Court date set to hear Public Service salary dispute

Members were kept informed in previous editions of the *Informus* regarding progress with the wage negotiations. Although the non-implementation of wage negotiations remains a thorny issue that requires an amicable solution, the PSA maintains its view that the Labour Court is the most suitable avenue to resolve this matter.

In the previous *Informus* the PSA indicated that a Labour Court date is awaited and that the PSA instructed its legal team to approach the Registrar of the Labour Court for an expedited date to address this long overdue matter.

The PSA subsequently received a set-down notice for the wage dispute. The matter will be heard before the Labour Appeal Court as a Court of First instance on 2 December 2020. The PSA is pleased that its request was favourably considered. In addition, the PSA is confident that the matter will be finally resolved through the Labour Appeal Court. The Notice further provides that all heads of arguments must be filed by no later than 20 November 2020 and that the matter will be dealt with by way of video conference, unless parties agree to file written submissions, which is unlikely in a matter of this magnitude.
