Relocation of CSPS to new building

Members will recall that the PSA tabled this item and demanded that the employer should expedite the relocation of employees to a new building owing to safety concerns. The employer delayed the process and blamed the Department of Public Works, which procures buildings on behalf of government departments. The PSA invoked clause 17 and at facilitation, some progress was made. The employer reported that the hand-over of the new building would take place during August 2021 but that the relocation was delayed as it was still waiting for the occupational certificate from the City of Tshwane. It was further reported that it was also busy installing security systems in the new building and that the process will be finalised by the end of November 2021.

COVID-19 report

The employer reported that it was still complying with COVID-19 regulations. It is still working from home and on a rotation system for employees who are unable to work from home. The employer also reported that it encourages employees to get a vaccination and only 33% were vaccinated.
