Update: The payment of the outstanding OSD by the Eastern Cape Department of Social Development (EC DSD)

The following item were discussed in detail during the above-mentioned meeting:

Implementation of Normal Grade Progression of the PHSDSBC *Resolution 1/2009* (OSD for Social Services Professionals)

The EC DSD failed to implement the Normal Grade Progression of the PHSDSBC *Resolution 1/2009* (OSD for Social Services Professionals).

Following multiple discussions and meetings at various levels, up to the PHSDSBC Chamber of the Eastern Cape, the PSA is pleased to report that the employer confirmed that the MEC of Health has approved the implementation of all outstanding payments. Implementation on PERSAL will start from 12-16 April 2021. The target date for the supplementary payment run will be on 21 April 2021. Simultaneous to the implementation of payments, letters will be sent to all OSD beneficiaries indicating the quantification of their payments, including those who didn't qualify and those who were overpaid previously.

Members allegedly overpaid will be dealt with as a separate process as that will need a lot of engagement by all the parties involved.
