# Feedback: COVID-19 Steering Committee

The COVID-19 Steering Committee convened a meeting on 9 July 2021 and the following agenda point were discussed:

## Provision of data/allowance for Steering Committee members

A recommendation made by the Steering Committee for members of the Committee who are required to attend virtual meetings be provided with data. The submission is still with the Chief Director Corporate Services, awaiting his approval. The Chairperson is to follow up and report back at the next meeting.

#### Thelma handheld scanners

Security Management made a submission that each directorate is to assist and each office to procure one temperature scanner. The submission is awaiting approval.

#### **Case investigation report**

Managers are to submit all outstanding and new COVID-19 Case Investigation Reports to the Wellness Section. The meeting noted the lack of compliance from some departments. It was resolved that Senior Managers must ensure that outstanding investigations are submitted within the provided time frames.

#### **District reports**

The Fezile Dabi COVID-19 District Report was presented to the meeting. The following outstanding issues were identified:

- The provision of additional data for members without departmental phones
- PPE not provided
  - o Gloves not available,
  - Face shield and
  - o Wipes
- Meeting resolved that management must ensure all the required PPE is provided to employees

## **Report: Status of COVID-19 training**

Training was suspended owing to COVID-19 precautionary measures. The Committee highlighted the importance of training. The meeting resolved that the Department must investigate alternative training methods as the importance of training cannot be discounted during this time.
