

Mosvold Hospital: Security challenges

The PSA's Provincial Office in Durban has received concerns from members owing to security challenges they are facing at Mosvold Hospital and clinics that fall under this institution. The PSA has been informed that the contract with Msinga Security Company for the provision of security services was terminated mainly owing to poor service delivery and disputes between management and its employees. As a result, a new agreement was entered into with a new entity to provide security services.

Owing to the appointment of a new security company, another dispute has arisen between employees of the new entity and Msinga Security Company. This dispute has escalated and now even involves the local councilors and izinduna. This untenable situation has led to the Hospital and clinics under the Hospital being without security guards, which compromises the safety of employees.

PSA's intervention

The PSA held an urgent meeting with the provincial Acting Director of Security, Mr Zondi, about the matter. Mr Zondi has committed to visit this institution together with District Director and to allocate the Health Department's security as a temporary measure up until the new security company has allocated its guards.
