Northern Cape: Special General Public Service Sectoral Bargaining Chamber meeting

A special Northern Cape GPSSBC Chamber sat on 17 September 2021. There was only one agenda point for discussion, namely OHS compliance and COVID-19 regulations.

OHS compliance and COVID-19 regulations

The employer made a presentation of how departments are complying with the above-mentioned regulations. According to the employer, this information was compiled as received from the Office of the Director-General. The objective of this presentation was to correct the wrongs of the past around COVID-19 Committees in the different departments. Departments claimed to have consulted with labour in the respective offices. Labour challenged the presentation as it holds a view that no departments have established active COVID-19 committees in the respective workplaces. Labour furthermore challenged the presentation as it did not give any indication of COIDA applications. A meeting to discuss the presentation and allow departments to respond to labour will be arranged before the next Chamber meeting.

Determination of vote weights

The following vote weights were adopted for the Provincial Chamber:

- PSA: 2 791 members (46.49%)
- Nehawu: 2 663 members (44.36%)
- Popcru: 549 members (9.15%)

Structure members are encouraged to continuously submit agenda items enabling the PSA to promote the interests of members at bargaining chamber level.
