Feedback: Medical-aid subsidy increased

Medical-aid subsidy: Annual adjustment

Labour has since last year, called on the employer to pronounce on the medical-aid inflation increase, which is due for implementation yearly on 1 January. Council also submitted correspondence to the employer, enquiring on the date of implementation. Subsequent to the *Informus* issued on 3 February 2021, the Department of Public Service and Administration provided a circular that indicates that the adjustment of the Medical Subsidy for Public Service Employees has been increased by 8.1 % as per Public Service Coordinating Bargaining Council Resolution 2 of 2015, i. e. by the Medical Price Index.

The increase is retrospective to 1 January 2021 and Persal will make the necessary adjustments.

Whilst the PSA welcomes the adjustment in the medical-aid subsidy, the Union will continue to oppose any increase in medical-aid fees in view of the fact that public servants have not received any salary adjustments that were due in 2020.
