The PSCBC gave a presentation of its 25th general meeting. The presentation was a summary of the 2021/22-annual report which speaks to the PSCBC's administrative actions, collective bargaining, and dispute management for the period concerned.

Disputes lodged comprised of PSCBC Resolutions:

- 7 of 2000 leave provisions,
- 1 of 2007 improvement in salaries and other conditions of service and overtime,
- 1 of 2003 disciplinary procedure,
- 3 of 2009 grade progression for non-OSD employees, and
- 1 of 2012 clause 18.1 and the qualification bonus.

The PSA calls on its representatives to ensure that all disputes are referred via the relevant Labour Relations Officer responsible for their department – this will ensure efficient service delivery and cut wasteful expenditure.
