A meeting was held on 4 August 2022 where the following issues were discussed:

### Annual General Meeting

The Annual General Meeting of the Civilian Secretariat for Police Service (CSPS) was held on 4 August 2022. The PSA remains the majority Union with the following figures announced by the secretariat for noting by parties:
