## Feedback: Departmental Bargaining Chamber meeting – 9 February 2022

### Relocation of CSPS to new building

Members will recall the PSA tabled this item and demanded that the employer should expediate relocation of employees to a new building owing to the safety concerns. The employer delayed the process and blamed the Department of Public Works, which procures buildings on behalf of government departments. The PSA invoked clause 17 and at the facilitation meeting some progress was made and the PSA reserved its right. In the previous meeting the employer reported that the hand-over of the new building would take place in August 2021. The employer now reported that relocation is anticipated to take place between March and April 2022 owing to the delay in receiving the occupational certificate from the City of Tshwane. The implementation of a rotation system has, however, mitigated the congestion that was impacting heavily on the safety of employees.

### COVID-19 report

The employer reported that it was still complying with COVID-19 regulations. Employees are still working from home with a rotation system for employees who are unable to work from home. The PSA noted the report and continue to monitor compliance to ensure employees' safety. The PSA encourages members to vaccinate although the vaccination must be on a voluntary basis upon ascertaining all pros and cons.
