Feedback: Departmental Bargaining Chamber Meeting - 15 June 2022

A virtual meeting took place on 15 June 2022 where the following issues were discussed:

COVID-19 regulations

The employer reported that it had three positive cases from the last DBC, 100% of staff is back at work, and all protocols are still being followed. The PSA noted the report and encouraged the employer to continue being cautious in managing the pandemic.

Review of organisational structure

The employer indicated that the organisational structure has been approved by the Minister. The PSA voiced disappointment and discontent as the concerns it raised with the Deputy Director-General on 4 May 2022 have not been addressed. The PSA rejected the structure and requested for facilitation through section 17 of the Governance rules.

Matching and placement

The employer indicated that the matching and placement process is currently taking place where employees on levels 2 to 12 are required to make two choices of their preference for placement on the new structure. The PSA is encouraging members to take the opportunity to make their choices for placement. All disputes emanating from the placement will be dealt with at a later stage.
