## Feedback: CCPECP Chamber meeting - 4 August 2022

A CCPECP Chamber meeting was held on 4 August 2022 and the following items were discussed:

- Occupational Health and Safety report, which was noted by labour for discussion in the next meeting.
- Moratorium on implementation of service-delivery models and organisational structures by departments of the Eastern Cape Provincial Administration.

The employer indicated that it will not entertain the issue of the moratorium on implementation of service-delivery model. The PSA supported the item and suggested that the employer should investigate that matter.

- Revoking of support and adoption of the Early-Childhood Function Shift-out report

The PSA submitted the following agenda items:

- Non-compliance with PSCBC Resolution 3/2009, with specific reference the Grade Progression Model for employees who completed continuous service of 12 and 15 years on the relevant salary levels.
- Non-compliance with PSCBC Resolution 7/2015, with specific reference to the payment of accumulated savings to assist employees when acquiring homeownership, building, and improving a home.

The employer indicated that an investigation will be conducted into the two items sponsored by the PSA and will report back in the next meeting.

The Office of The Premier (OTP) condemned all Departments for not complying with the resolutions and committed to ensure compliance. The OTP insisted that the employer does not lack capacity to implement the resolutions but reluctance to do so. The OTP ordered the employer to report on these matters in the next meeting. The next CCPECP meeting will be held on 2 September 2022 and the AGM will be held on 17 August 2022.
