Provincial report: COVID-19

The employer reported that the COVID-19 command center sitting at the Office of the Premier has been disbanded. The disbanding came as a result of the upliftment of COVID-19 restrictions. The PSA noted the position of the employer, and it was resolved that this item be removed from the agenda.

Condition of buildings: Gauteng Provincial Departments

The Chamber expected a detailed update report on progress made with the different issues on Gauteng buildings. The employer, however, failed to provide the report and requested the Chamber for more time until the next meeting to provide the report. The employer made an excuse in that the person responsible for the report was on leave. The PSA raised concern and indicated that the employer is not serious about its commitment to resolving the issues of buildings. The PSA demanded that a report be provided electronically to the Chamber for deliberation at the next meeting.

Provincial PMDS report

The employer reported that the 2019/20-financial year has been finalised throughout provincial departments. The Gauteng Department of Health and Gauteng COGTA has, however, not yet finalised payments of PMDS pay progression for employees. The Department of Health has not implemented the 2020/21-financial year PMDS payments, and this matter is being deliberated at the Provincial Chamber for the Public Health and Social Development Sectorial Bargaining Council.

The PSA also noted that the employers in various departments are not applying the PMDS policy consistently and there are many issues regarding Moderation Committees and the manner they operate. The PSA demanded a PMDS policy review workshop where a common understanding of the policy and operation of Moderation Committees will be discussed. It was resolved that the CCPGP will facilitate a PMDS policy workshop.
