

Update: Department of Employment and Labour: Durban Centre

Non-compliance: Occupational health and safety (OHS) and operational standards

Members on 20 October 2022 reported the following non-compliance with OHS and operational standards:

- Lift not working since February 2022
- No fire extinguishers on certain floors
- Air conditioners not working
- Dangerous electrical wiring
- Staff overcrowding in offices
- Toilets not working
- Telephone-line faults
- Inadequate printing machine facilities for building
- No active health and safety committee

The PSA requested pro-active inspection to ensure compliance with OHS. This was immediately reported to the KZN Provincial Chief Inspectors to conduct inspections, which resulted in the issuing of a non-compliance order issued by the Department of Employment and Labour. Members will be updated on developments.
