## Feedback: Limpopo GPSSBC Chamber meeting - 24 June 2022

### **OHS compliance and COVID-19 regulations**

Members will recall that it was previously reported that there had been no further COVID-19 casualties since the previous meeting and that the status is still the same. The employer is still observing COVID-19 protocols and continues to provide hand sanitiser. Following the announcement by the Minister of Health on 22 June 2022, parties agreed to remove the item from the agenda.

### **GPSSBC Resolution 5/2014: Recognition of Improved Qualifications**

Members will recall that it was previously reported that all departments had received concurrence letters from the Department of Public Service and Administration (DPSA), except for Education and COGHSTA. The outcome was still awaited by these two departments. The employer reported that it is constantly engaging the DPSA and that an addendum to the existing list of qualifications has been applied. Progress will be reported in the next meeting.

### **Consultation of Policies outside Chamber: Department of Transport and Community Safety**

The agenda item was deferred to a special meeting of the GPSSBC. The date has yet to be determined.

### **Relocation: Department of Transport and Community Safety Capricorn District Offices in Lebowakgomo to Polokwane**

The PSA has noted that the Department is busy relocating the Capricorn District Offices in Lebowakgomo to Polokwane following the merger with the Department of Safety and Community Liaison. The item was deferred to a special meeting of the GPSSBC of which the date has yet to be confirmed.
