## Update: DDPPs and Chief Prosecutors - SCA judgment

Members have been informed that the Supreme Court of Appeal (SCA) ruled against the PSA to have all Deputy Directors of Public Prosecution (DDPPs) and Chief Prosecutors (CP) translated to LP 10 on the OSD scales.

The PSA discussed the judgment with its legal representatives and a decision was made that a new application must be made to the Constitutional Court (CC). The application to the Constitutional Court is not a review exercise but rather a new action. Members should take note that all parties were served with the application. The PSA can also confirm that the new application was submitted to the Constitutional Court. The Court will evaluate the application and will rule if the matter will be heard. The PSA is confident that a strong case was made out why the Constitutional Court can be approached for direct access and why the matter is of public interest and should be adjudicated by the Constitutional Court and not a lower court.

Members will be informed of developments.
