## Update: DDPPs cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) dispute

Members were previously informed that the PSA declared a dispute on behalf of members who are appointed as Deputy Directors of Public Prosecutions (DDPP) who do not receive the same COLA (salary increase) and other legally qualified employees. The matter was dismissed by Labour Court, however, the PSA successfully petitioned the Labour Appeal Court to hear the matter. The matter was subsequently set down for hearing of arguments on 5 May 2022.

The matter was heard on 5 May 2022, as scheduled, where all parties argued their case before three judges. Judgement was, however, reserved.
