Update: Adjustment of medical-aid subsidy

Members will recall that PSCBC *Resolution 2/2015* makes provision for the adjustment of medical assistance for in-service employees who belong to the Government Employees Medical Scheme (GEMS) and all former employees on all medical schemes, in accordance with the Medical Price Index (MPI) adjustment for a particular year, which will be adjusted w.e.f. 1 January of each year.

The Department of Public Service and Administration issued a circular on 31 January 2022 on the adjustment of medical subsidy of 6.42% with effect from 1 January 2022. The circular is *attached* for ease of refence.

The PSA wants to take this opportunity to wish all employees who are unwell owing to COVID-19 a safe and speedy recovery.
