SARS strike underway

PSA members at SARS are either on the street or staying away in pursuit of reasonable salary increase after rejecting a paltry 1.39%-salary increase offer. The strike commenced today and will be indefinite until the arrongant employer listens.

Border posts closed

Mananga, Qachas, Beitbridge, Skilpadhek, Groblersbrug, Nakop and Kopfontein.

Management teams are trying in some offices to assist the public but are not coping. Contact Centres are operating at 50%.

Members are encouraged to liaise with PSA shop stewards and Provincial Offices for details regarding the strike action. The strike can only be effective if members get out in big numbers. The 'no-work, no-pay' principle should not deter workers to participate in this strike as we need to make a statement, alternatively, the employer will continue to offer employees a paltry increase.
