FOR PSA MEMBERS: CROSS BORDER ROADS TRANSPORT AGENCY (CBRTA)

PSA maintains its majority status at CBRTA and the recognition agreement remains effective

As members are aware that on 1 April 2023, employees from the Road Transport Inspectorate (RTI) were transferred to CBRTA which increased the workforce and ultimately affected the majority status of PSA at CBTA. On 2 May 2023, CBRTA issued a notice to the PSA that its membership went down to 39,5% as a result of the transfer and gave PSA 30 days to remedy the situation in line with the recognition agreement.

On 16 May 2023, the PSA held a branch meeting and a recruitment drive to inform members of the situation it was faced with and requested members to assist in recruiting more members to attain the majority status. On 29 May 2023, the PSA wrote to the CBRTA that it has remedied the situation by submitting 49 new membership forms.

The PSA is delighted to inform members that CBRTA has confirmed that the PSA managed to remedy the situation with a membership of 58.1% and that the recognition agreement will continue to be effective without any alterations. The PSA sends its gratitude to all shop stewards and members who assisted in remedying the situation. This paves the way for the PSA to continue to protect the rights and enhance the interests of members by engaging CBRTA in the bargaining forum on outstanding matters *i.e.*, the Patterson grading system, hybrid working model, bursaries, danger allowance, *etc.*
